



Dr Chhaya Goswami, Honorary University Fellow, University of Exeter, UK, specializes in the western Indian Ocean maritime history. She has authored two books on the maritime trading linkages of Kachchh entitled *The Call of the Sea, Kachchhi Traders in Muscat and Zanzibar c.1800-1880* (Orient BlackSwan 2011) and *Globalization Before its Time, The Gujarati Merchants from Kachchh* (Penguin Books 2016). She has also published several research papers in edited volumes and journals. Her two of the research papers were awarded best paper prizes by the Indian History Congress. Recently, her first book *The Call of the Sea* was awarded as the prestigious best book prize called Pandit Hiralal Gupta Prize by the Indian History Congress. She mainly works on commodity trading between Kachchh, Muscat, Zanzibar, diaspora studies, business history and oral history. She also published several research papers in edited volumes and national and international journals. Her two of the research papers were awarded best paper prizes by the Indian History Congress.

Her current research project focuses on *Maritime Trade and Piracy in the Gulfs of Kachchh and Persia 1750-1820*.
