1.	Is they (IGNCA) appointed any nodal officer to deal with the PFRDA as suggested by Ministry of Culture?	NPS is not implemented in IGNC A
2.	Is IGNC A approach the Ministry of Culture for allocation of funds to meet the additional expenditure to be incurred by them while meeting the matching contribution, which IGNC A have to remit with PFRDA while joining the NPS-2004?	-No-
3.	What is the amount available at IGNC A as employees contribution?	As on 31.03.2014 the IGNC A employees contribution accumulated to their CP Fund Accounts and accounted for in the annual accounts for the year 2013-2014 is to the tune of Rs-14.79 Crore.
4.	Is IGNC A depositing the employees share to PF fund in every month for investment ?What is the accumulated amount?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The employees share deducted from the pay and allowances of the employees is being credited to the fund every month. The CP Fund amount is always kept invested as per the Government guidelines.• As per the audited annual account for the year 2013-14,the accumulated amount for the year 2013-14 is Rs-24,58,88,187/-in CP Fund.

5.	What is the method of investment of this money?	The accumulated fund is being invested as per the guidelines of Government of India. All the funds are invested in the fixed deposits with the Nationalized Banks.
6.	When did IGNC A actually complete the process of shifting to NPS-2004?	As above at serial No.1.
7.	Is the employees retiring in 2014 and 16 will be accommodated in the scheme?	-Do-
8.	The reason for implementing the NPS-2004 scheme, since all the regular employees of IGNC A are appointed on or before 2004 and are eligible for pension under the old scheme, may be given?	There is no scope for providing information based on interpretation as per section 2F,I & J of RTI act.
9.	Reason for not implementing CGHS Scheme after retirement, even though the Ministry of Health communicated its approval for CGHS benefit after retirement?	In accordance with Ministry of Health Communication OPD, after retirement CGHS Scheme is approved by Competent Authority in IGNC A.
